Assistant Chief Strayer gave a Fire Department report. He discussed grants and said they have applied for a grant for Jaws of Life.

Mr. Keith Kreager from Crystal Rock and our Rural Water representative was at the meeting.

Fiscal Officer Mary Ann mentioned that we need to stop our spending and get all invoices from this year turned in so they can be paid by the end of December.

Melissa from Storm Water plans to be at our meeting on December 1, 2016.

Mr. Bias mentioned that negotiations with the Firefighters will begin soon.
