

The Margaretta Township Trustees met in regular session on June 1, 2017 at 7 p.m.

Present were Mr. Pooch, Mr. Riesterer and Mr. Bias.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve the minutes from the May 18, 2017 meeting as presented by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve and sign warrant #16119-16153 and efts that were submitted for payment by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to accept the financial reports that were submitted by the Fiscal Officer. Vote: all ayes

Bay Bridge residents: Danny Kiser, Wendy Salyers, Carol & Gary Keller were all at the meeting with concerns about their storm sewers. The Trustees explained that this issue is the counties responsibility. After discussing the issue and listening to the residents Mr. Riesterer suggested that the residents get on the Erie County Commissioners meeting agenda and that we would support them there.

Mr. Mark Michaels was at the meeting with water concerns with the Caswell Ditch. He asked about doing a ditch petition. There was a discussion on the water concerns.

Mr. Jim Neill gave a Cemetery/Road Dept report. Jim had a list of possible summer help people.

Mr. Pooch moved, seconded by Mr. Bias to hire the following part time summer help: Collin Lane, Trent Jones and Conner Swartz all at the rate of \$9.50/hr and to rehire Jason Gearheart for the summer at a rate of \$10.50/hr

Chief Johnson gave his Fire Department report

The disposal of 100 was discussed. It was decided that Chief Johnson would advertise it and take bids until July 6, 2017.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr., Pooch to purchase a Lucas Compression System for a cost not to exceed \$16,500. Vote: all ayes

Several Zoning issues were discussed. Mr. Pickard was concerned with a pole barn in Crystal Rock. He said there were deed restrictions in Crystal Rock. Mr. Johnson told him we have nothing to do with deed restrictions.

Mr. Johnson said he has sent out violations for mowing.
