The Margaretta Township Trustees met in regular session June 20, 2013 at 7 p.m.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve the minutes from the June 6, 2013 meeting, as presented by Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann Lindsley. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve and sign warrants #12558-12589, that were presented by the Fiscal Officer for payment. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to accept the financial reports submitted by Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann Lindsley. Vote: all ayes.

Chief Mohr gave his Fire Department report. Chief Mohr would like to start an explorer program in the Fire Department.

Chief mentioned that we will be receiving an AFG Grant for rescue equipment. We will receive \$23,235 and we will be putting in an additional \$1222.

The new GMC truck is in service.

The grass fire truck tank and skid should be complete by Friday.

The property maintenance code was discussed.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve the vacation request of Dean Gasser for July 13, 2013. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to scrape our old light plant trailer. Vote: all ayes

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to pass Resolution 2013-07: adopting the most current edition of the National Property Maintenance Code as published and approved by the International Code Council and as amended by this resolution. Roll Call Vote: Mr. Bias- yes, Mr. Riesterer-yes Mr. Pooch- absent.

Mr. Jim Johnson gave a storm water update. He said at a meeting on June 12, 2013 there was a discussion on the possibility of forming a Storm Water District.

Mr. Tom Johnson gave his zoning update. He said that Terry Nickels said the tree stump on the property he demolished will be cleaned up soon. We will not give him his payment until all the work is done.

Mr. Jim Neill gave his Road/Cemetery report. The road project for Old RR was discussed.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to accept the preliminary estimated cost of \$11,080.60 for the Old RR repair and resurface Phase I project. Vote: all ayes

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to approve advertising for bids for the Old RR repair and resurface project, accepting bids until 7 p.m. on July 11, 2013, with bids to be opened that night. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to grant Jim Neill's vacation request for 6 days; June 21 – June 28, 2013. Vote: all ayes.

Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to accept the maintenance agreement with ODOT for the use of Homegardner Rd. during the upcoming closure of St Rt 101. Vote: all ayes.

Ms. Jane Ann Williams came into the meeting. She said everything is a go for the Ohio Flags of Honor to be held during the Cold Creek Celebration July 19 - July 21, 2013.

Trustees discussed putting a Cemetery Levy on the November ballot. This levy would be used for the cost of running the Cemetery along with hopefully saving for the purchase of land in the future for the Cemetery. The trustees feel we will be running out of our present cemetery land in about 15 years. The trustees will start the paperwork to see if we want to go forward with this.

Fiscal Officer, Mary Ann had a mutual aid agreement from Townsend Township. The Trustees tabled this until the first meeting of July.

After looking over insurance quotes for our medical insurance the following motion was made. Mr. Bias moved, seconded by Mr. Riesterer to continue with our health insurance through Medical Mutual at the proposed renewal rate of 26+ percent. Vote: all ayes.

The trustees mentioned the following grants that have been received by the township recently: The Road Department received an ODOT grant in the amount of \$23,358 for the replacement of street signs on township roads. They also will receive a grant for \$29,000 to resurface Old Railroad Road. The Fire Department is receiving a fire grant to purchase rescue equipment in the amount of \$24,000. The County Commissioners have approved a \$21,000 CDBG grant for the township to remodel the town hall to make it ADA compliant.

The township is also receiving a Tire Amnesty Grant through Erie County Solid Waste Management District to cover some of the cost for our tire recycling program.
